

EDLAVITCH DCJCC REOPENING GUIDELINES

As of June 15, 2020

In preparation for the reopening of the Edlavitch DCJCC below is a working outline of many of the guidelines and procedures that will be used, once the building reopens, to ensure safety for all. Please note that these guidelines, which pertain to all EDCJCC visitors and staff, will change over time as we receive new information and updates from the DC Government, CDC, OSHA, and our licensing agencies, which include the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE).

All the effort that has gone into the preparation of this guideline and the plans to reopen the building is to ensure the EDJCC is as safe an environment as possible.

OVERALL HEALTH NOTICE

Anyone with a current COVID-19 diagnosis, or experiencing any of the following symptoms listed below associated with COVID-19, is asked that not come to the EDCJCC in order to keep everyone as safe as possible.

If anyone has had contact with a person that has been diagnosed with or suspected to have COVID-19 within the last 14 days, we ask that you not come to the facility for a minimum of 14 days from the date of exposure. Potential symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 or higher
- Cough
- Chills
- Headache
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Muscle pain
- Abdominal distress

If someone is diagnosed with COVID-19 they may not return to the EDCJCC until:

- They are fever free for three consecutive days, and;
- Their symptoms have improved, and;
- It has been ten days since the symptoms first appeared; or
- They have tested negative twice, 24 hours apart, for COVID-19.

OVERVIEW

- Temperature check upon entry for everyone that enters;
- Waiver or Health form to be signed virtually or in print before entering the building;
- Face coverings for all visitors, including staff, is required;
- Social distancing of 6 feet or more is required throughout the building;
- Everyone in the building will be asked to perform frequent hand hygiene;
- Plexiglass barriers have been placed around Front Desk;
- Increased signage throughout the building to enforce new guidelines;
- Water fountains turned off, water bottle refills only;
- Coffee bar, vending machines, Catering Kitchen, and concessions not available currently;
- Recommended that people use stairways whenever possible;
- Social distancing on elevators must be maintained;

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CLEANING AND SANITIZING

- All protocols will meet or exceed CDC and EPA guidelines;
- All cleaning staff will wear masks and gloves throughout the day;
- Increased cleaning and sanitizing will be done continually throughout the day;
- Additionally, at least once a month the center will be closed for a deep clean and sanitation of the entire facility;
- Hand sanitizer stations have been added throughout the facility;
- Additional circulation of fresh air will be maintained throughout the building using our new HVAC and Direct Outdoor Air Supply Units (DOAS Unit);

FITNESS CENTER

- Advanced reservations are required for use of the Fitness Center;
- Pool, locker rooms, and steam rooms are closed at this time;
- Equipment has been reconfigured for social distancing and will be at least 10 feet apart;
- No more than 5 people allowed per 1,000 square feet in any area: seven main fitness area, three in group exercise room; 3 in Parenting Center / Fitness Studio;
- Members are required to wipe each individual piece of equipment after each use;
- Increased cleaning of the equipment and spaces will be done by the staff after each overall session and throughout the day;
- No towel service is provided - members should bring their own towels;

PRESCHOOL

- There will be no more than 10 people (staff and students) at a time;
- Parents are not allowed in the building and must drop off and pick up outside at preset staggered times;
- Temperature checks of students will be done at drop off before parent leaves;
- Daily questionnaire must be filled out and signed by a parent/guardian virtually;
- No sharing of classroom spaces by other classes or groups;
- Communal play spaces and large rooms will not be used at this time;
- Playground equipment at the EDCJCC and Stead Park cannot be used at this time;
- Staff must always wear masks;
- Only one class at a time can use bathrooms and they must be cleaned between use;
- Rooms will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized throughout the day and at the end of each day
